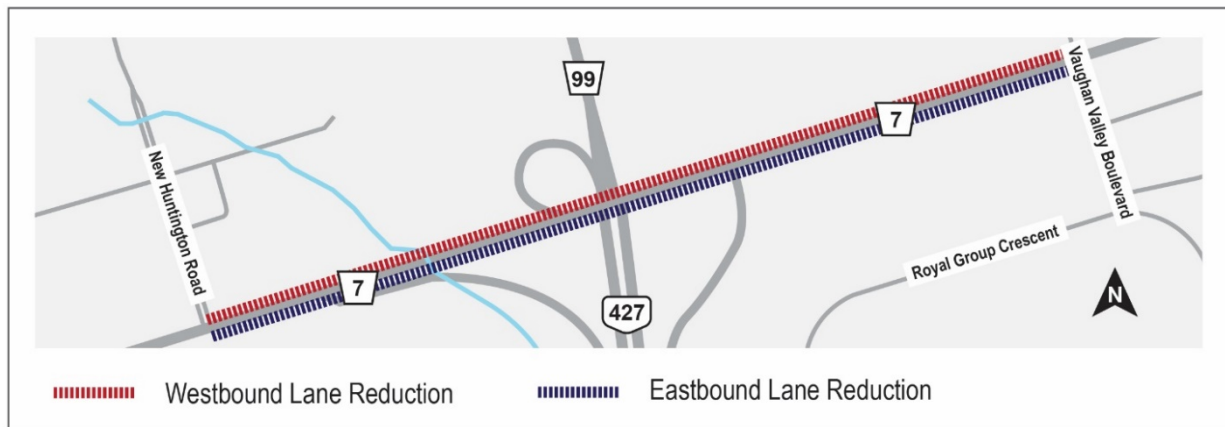


Bulletin #11: Long-term Highway 7 Lane Reductions

On **May 2, 2019**, Highway 7 between Vaughan Valley Boulevard and New Huntington Road will be reduced to two lanes in each direction **until July 2020**. Motorists are advised to plan alternate routes for the duration of the closure. Thank you for your patience and understanding.



These lane reductions are needed to facilitate improvements to the Highway 7 underpass and the construction of the new ramps at Highway 7 as part of the Highway 427 extension.

Additional Information:

LINK427 was awarded a fixed-price contract by the MTO and IO to design, build, finance and maintain the expansion of Highway 427. LINK427 will be responsible for the maintenance, construction, lifecycle repair and renewal of the works for the 30 years following completion.

Highway 427 will be extended by 6.6 kilometres from Highway 7 to Major Mackenzie Drive, and widened to 8 lanes from Finch Avenue to Highway 7. The project is anticipated to be complete in 2021.
